**SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**

A special board meeting of the Hinton Community School District Board of Directors was held in the school library on Wednesday, March 2, 2011.

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Board President, Rob Held.

**QUORUM**

Roll call was conducted by Board Secretary, Melissa Sanders .

Board Secretary Sanders stated that a quorum was present.

**CONSENT ITEMS**

Approve amended agenda: Motion by Riediger, Second by Blanchard, it was RESOLVED: To approve the amended agenda (to discuss and consider the superintendent's recommendation to increase pre-school tuition for the FY12 school year; to discuss but not act upon a tentative collective bargaining agreement with the Hinton Education Association, and to discuss but not act upon the potential need for reductions of positions in light of budget constraints).  
Motion carried 5-0.

**REPORTS/INFORMATION**

Jane Krehbiel, Elementary Principal, provided data regarding surrounding area Preschool and Day Care rates, discussed potential enrollment projections for the 2011-2012 school year, the unresolved matters of Iowa's General Assembly funding next year for pre school, and recommended an increase of \$10.00 per week for all day preschool with extended daycare (increased to \$110 from \$100) and an increase of \$20.00 per week for preschool only (increased to \$50 from \$30).
