WHEREAS, the Plymouth County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan includes a profile of hazard events, a vulnerability assessment, evaluation of mitigation goals and a plan of maintenance process, and

WHEREAS, the Hinton Public School District set October 21, 2013, as a public hearing date to review and adopt the plan; and
